



Some superb racing was the order of the day for July's Formula Atlantic Triple Crown Race. One of the dices of the day was between Scot Bernie Hunter (4) and Irishman Vivian Candy (7).

Welcome home, Jackie! That must be the main event of the day, the long awaited return to Scotland's premier motor racing circuit of three times World Motor Racing Champion, Jackie Stewart. Despite having retired from the track, Jackie's personality and many business interests have ensured that he is in constant demand all over the world, and thus it is many years now since we have enjoyed his presence at a motor racing event in Scotland. Today Jackie makes up for all of that absence. Dropping in by helicopter for a bit of lunch (courtesy of Gleneagles Helicopters and your actual Tommy Dickson, father of Norman — there used to be a time it was the other way round!), Jackie will again have to mix business with pleasure as, over lunch, he receives a spot of tuition in the noble art of flag dropping from that master of the saltire, Mac McMillan! Yes you've guessed it — the first item on Jackie's agenda for the day will be to unleash the fury of the Formula Fords, by starting the **Carnies of Edinburgh Trophy Race** at 2.00 p.m. And even if his hand does waver just a bit while the flag is up there (after all, who is going to protest about a bum start when the ace of aces is doing the dirty!) a word of advice for those competitors who have watched Jackie start a race before — his eyes turn green when it's time to go!

In amongst the formula ford pack you will no doubt have noticed entries for David Harper and Robert Foden, both of R.F. Racing. That team is, in fact, backed by the 4th Royal Tank Regiment and hence the musical display from the pipes and drums of the 4th Royal Tank Regiment immediately in front of the main grandstand at 1.20 p.m. At the time of going to press the pipe band fully intended to be here, although they could see one or two clouds on the horizon which could just conceivably prevent their presence, so please give them the usual rousing reception if they are able to make it.

After the first FF race (and don't forget that the first two Shell Championship competitors in that event have another bite at the cherry in event 5 today) it's time for the first heat of the main race of the day, the OPEL DEALERS TROPHY RACE for Special Saloons. list of those involved is given on page 13 of this programme - quite an achievement to bring so many dealers together in common cause, and one welcomed and warmly supported by Scotcircuits. Aptly presenting their trophy to the saloon car race, the first heat sees a return confrontation between Walter Robertson's DFVW (105) and Doug Niven's Beetle (101). Up until July, Dougal looked pretty well invincible with this car all over Britain, but time has taken its toll and, in the first saloon car heat in July at Ingliston, Doug had all of his work cut out keeping Walter at Bay. Walter, in fact, took fastest lap in that heat and it was clear that his newly rebuilt DFV mill was delivering its full quota of power. Herbina, on the other hand, was sadly in need of a re-build, and it showed as, in the final, Walter outgunned everyone in the start of his life, to scream into the lead he was never to relinquish. For all that, fastest lap in the final went to Dougal, just as a reminder that even a tired Beetle ain't beaten yet! Now that Doug's done the old re-build job, today's race should be a corker. Just keep a weather eye peeled, though, for Jimmy Jack (103) in a new 2 litre Davrian Stilletto Ford - cars like this (and particularly Rob Mason's) have been going indecently fast down south and it's only been a matter of time before someone twigged that this combination could be a revelation at Ingliston. After all, John Kirk amazed a few of you with his 1300 cc Imp last October, didn't he!

And as if the excitement of the big saloons isn't enough (which it probably isn't), we are asking Jackie if he would be prepared to share the commentary on this race with Jimmy McInnes. Oh what we do for you spectators! Too much more excitement won't be good for you, but that's what you're going to get in the **Heron Rossleigh Trophy Race** for Sports Cars. With Jim Stevenson's mighty Mallock back (30) and a welcome appearance by the winner of two of the Donington rounds of the Dinwoodie Lodge Hotel Championship, Chris Hodgetts with his Gryphon (31), we seemed set for a tense race anyway, but now we've thrown in the 2-litre Chevron B36 of Lawrence Jacobsen (25) just to liven things up.
